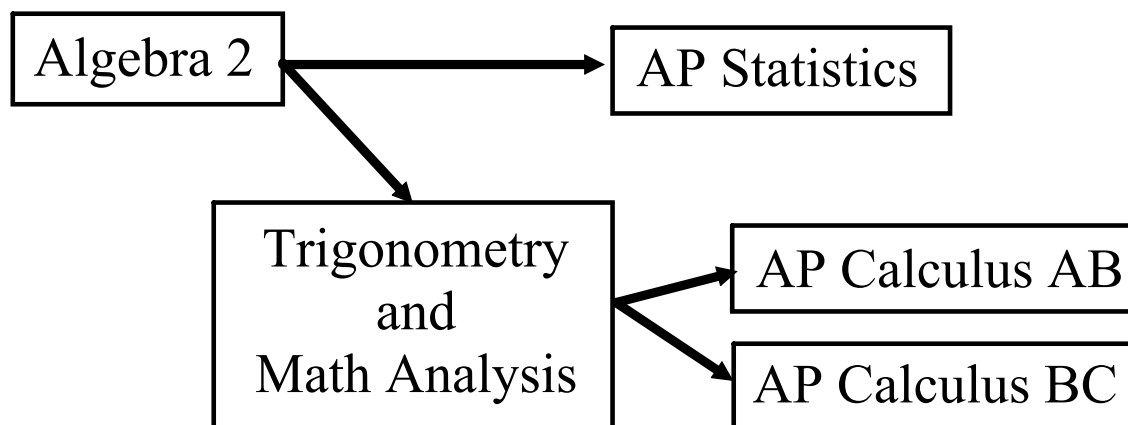

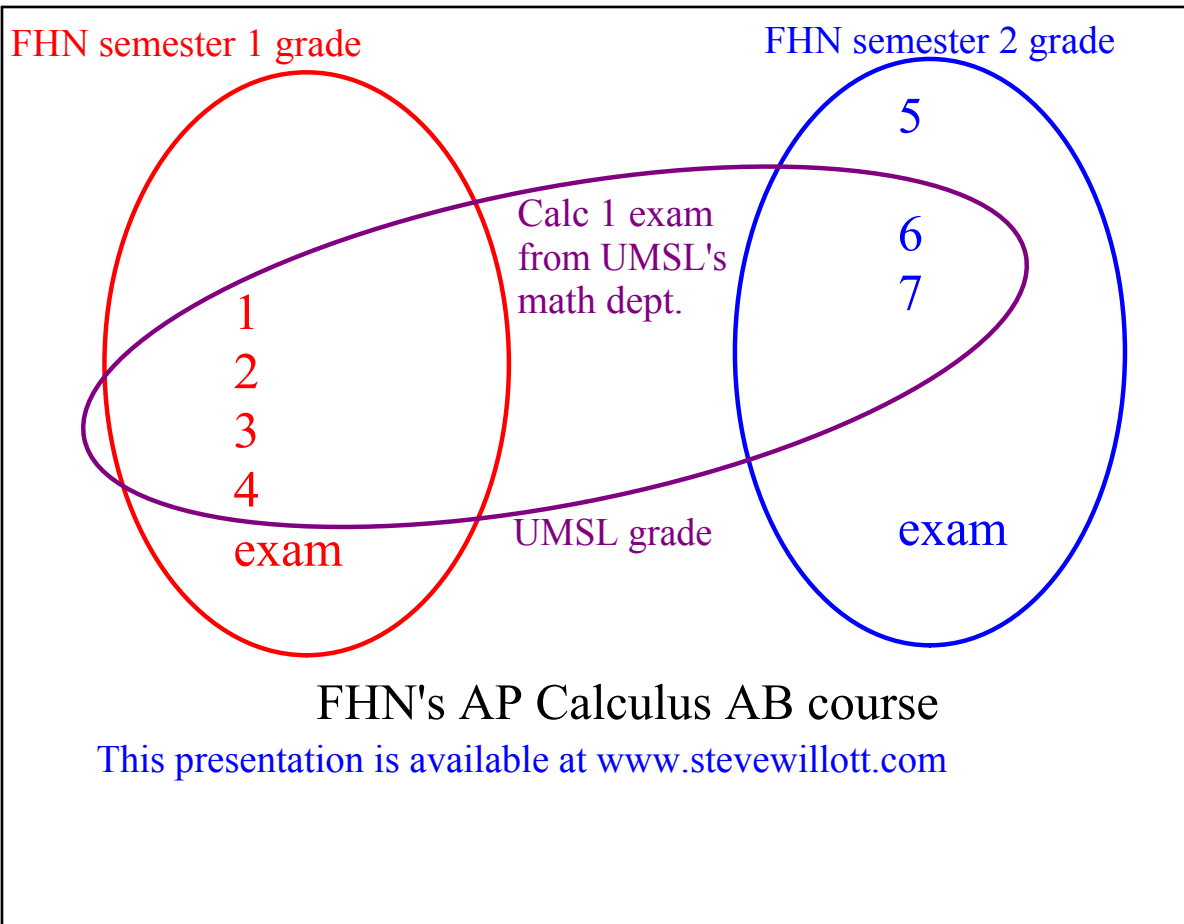

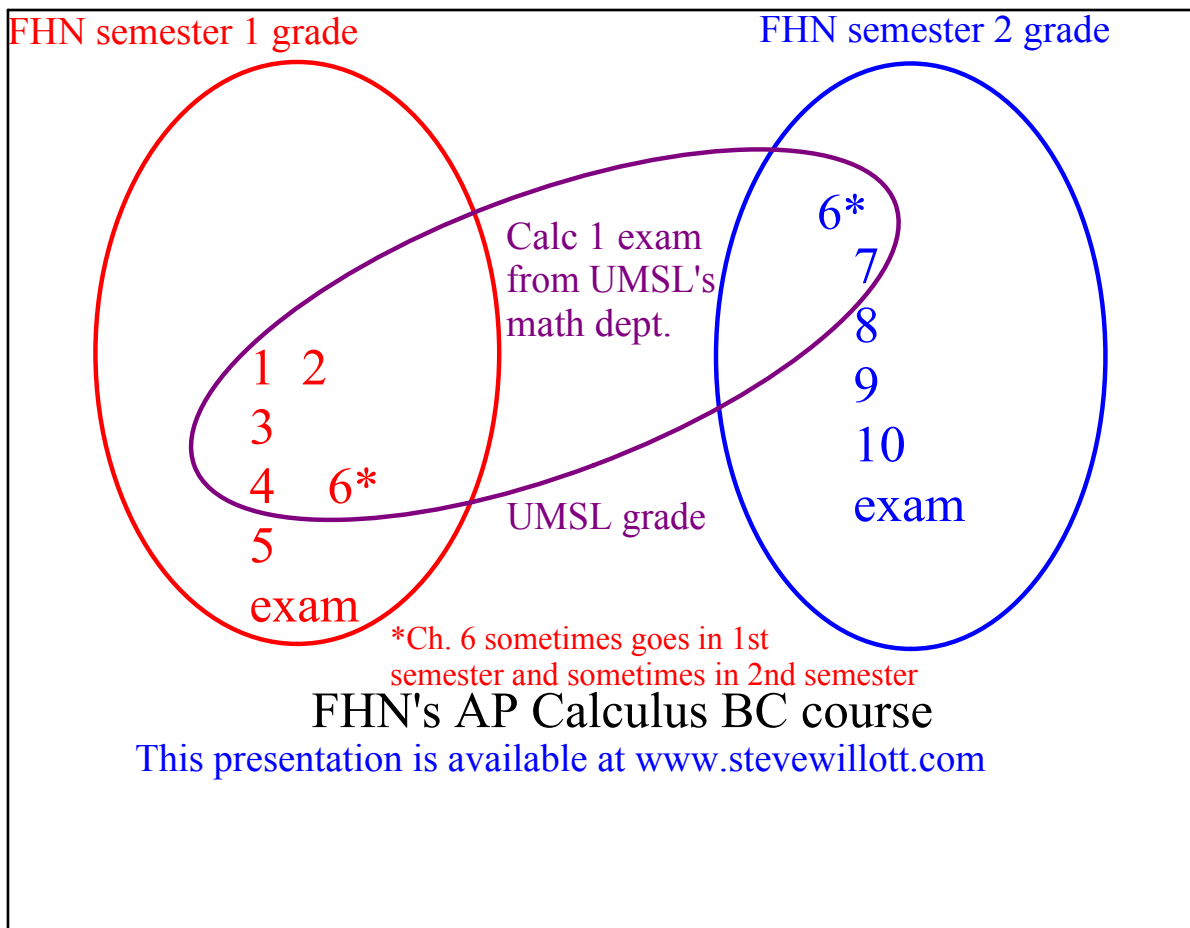

- no single answer
- varies by student
- varies by university

### neither

- choose to re-take
- decide not needed
- don't feel confident/successful
- desire high school credit only

### UMSL

- simple transfer
- based on consistent work
- not based on a single test
- cheaper than at University

### AP

- experience college-level exam
- transfer
- exempt from sem. 2 exam w/C
- cheaper than UMSL

### both

- possibly double-up
- flexibility
- delay decision
- exempt from sem. 2 exam w/C

The receiving institution decides whether credit will be accepted for transfer. Call Admissions or the Registrar at the university you want to transfer credit to.

- “Do you accept University of Missouri at Saint Louis’ Math 1800 or Math 1310 for transfer credit?”
- "Does it transfer as a particular course, a math elective, or a general elective?"
- “Does it meet minimum requirements for required math courses toward my degree?”
- “Would I have to take any other math courses for my degree?”
- “Do I still have to take a math placement test?”
- “Can I take math courses beyond whatever Math 1800 or Math 1310 will transfer as?”
- “Does transferring Math 1800 or Math 1310 affect my g.p.a.?”
